



Mayor Chaz Molder Announces \$411k Raised in Q4, Surpassing \$1.21M raised in 2025.

Molder enters 2026 with over \$977k cash on hand.

COLUMBIA, TN: Candidate for U.S. Congress and Mayor of Columbia, Tennessee, **Chaz Molder** announced bringing in **\$411,000** in the final quarter of 2025. Molder closes out the year having **raised a whopping \$1,210,000 in only 4 months** in his bid for Tennessee's 5th Congressional District. In an impressive display of local momentum and support, Molder reports 92% of contributions received coming from Tennesseans.

"Kicking off the new year, I could not be more grateful for the thousands of people across this district who believe in our campaign," **Mayor Molder said**.
